

**Resolution from the Governing Council of MOVE**

That the following policies adopted by the Governing Council during the term under review be subjoined to the Constitution of the Society as Bye-Laws:

CORRESPONDING CONSTITUTION	PROPOSED BYE-LAW	REASON(S) FOR BYE-LAW
Article 4.1 (a)	"Salaried practitioners of volunteer programme management" for the purpose of interpretation shall be defined as all and anyone who are/is practising volunteer programme management whether directly or indirectly. This shall include all and anyone who contributes to volunteer programme management including but not limiting to those holding the positions of volunteer programme managers and coordinators, volunteer management trainers, volunteer management consultants and management and executive staff who engage volunteers in the course of delivering their roles and duties.	This is proposed in view of the diversity of the practice of Volunteer Programme Managers (VPM) and to cater to lateral job expansion of VPMs.
Article 4.1 (a)	For ambiguous or exceptionable cases, the Membership Committee shall review the applications and make recommendations for the Governing Council's final decision.	
No existing corresponding Article	All categories of members may contribute towards the growth and development of the Society by serving on the committees and/or sub-committees formed by the Governing Council. However, only Ordinary members shall be elected or co-opted to the Governing Council.	To create more opportunities for involvement in the growth and development of the Society by its Associate, Corporate and Honorary Members.
Article 6	Associate members who wish to convert to Ordinary membership between January and June of the financial year, may do so upon payment of pro-rate annual dues to be calculated at 50% of the Ordinary rate in force at the time of conversion.	To facilitate conversion of membership

Article 6	Associate members who wish to convert to Ordinary membership between July and December of the financial year, may do so on payment of pro-rate annual dues to be calculated at 25% of the Ordinary rate in force at the time of conversion.	To facilitate conversion of membership
Article 6	There shall be no refund of all or part of any annual dues paid to the Society in the case of Ordinary members converting to Associate membership at any juncture during the financial year.	
Article 6	In the event that the Governing Council extends waiver of annual dues for its members, all categories of members shall be deemed to have automatically renewed their membership for the said financial year. Any member who so wishes to discontinue its membership shall have to inform the Governing Council or its appointed committee in writing of their wish to do so.	To provide for automatic renewal in the event that annual fees are waived by the Governing Council.
